



## After School Child Safety K-6

We work hard together, as a school community, to ensure our children are safe whilst they are on school grounds. A particular area of risk is the time after classes have finished for the day. We have a large number of children moving to different areas of the school and many vehicles coming and going in a short space of time. The following guidelines assist us to maintain a safe environment during this busy time.

### Kindergarten Afternoon Pick-Up

- If you are picking up your Kindergarten child, please park your car in the bottom car park and come up to the Kindergarten to collect your child (please leave your mobile phone in the car).
- Please do not send a sibling to the Kindergarten to collect your child and bring him/her down to the car park.
- If your child is travelling home by bus, a staff member will deliver your child from the Kindergarten to the bus waiting area, where another staff member will be on duty to supervise.

### Primary School Afternoon Pick-Up

- Please park your car in the bottom car park and come and collect your child from the waiting areas outside the Performance Hall (over the main timber bridge).
- Please do not wait in the car for your child to walk across the car park. The car park is a very busy area at this time and it is not safe for children to walk unaccompanied into the car park.
- We have teachers on duty at the bottom car park during pick up times, however once you have met up with your child in the waiting area, your child is in your care. Please actively supervise them from this point.

### Friday Markets

- We have teachers on duty until 3.30 pm on Fridays, however you are responsible for supervising your own children at all times during the market.
- Children are only allowed to play on the top 'green' area of the school. Please do not allow your children to run or play through other areas of the school.
- The only piece of playground equipment which may be used during the Friday market are the low monkey bars located next to the 'climbing tree' on the top green of the school. Please supervise your children to ensure that play on this equipment is safe (i.e. no standing or jumping off the top of the monkey bars, no pushing other children etc.)
- At 3.30 pm our teachers finish their duty. At this time the market closes and we ask that you collect your children and leave the site.
- From time to time we may have additional social events in conjunction with the Friday markets and the finishing time may be extended. We will let you know if this is the case.
