Application to Complete an International Student Exchange

CBRSS Student Exchange Opportunity is a reciprocal program whereby a CBRSS student attends a Secondary Steiner School and enrol in a full-time school program in another country for a minimum period of 1 month to a maximum period of 3 months in duration. Under similar conditions, students from overseas undertake study at CBRSS.

The principal purpose of a Student Exchange is to provide a broad educational experience for students and to further international/intercultural understanding.

The student completing the exchange is as an ambassador for our School and therefore application does not necessarily ensure the exchange will be approved.

This application may make reference to demonstrated involvement and continuous, positive participation in a range of co-curricular & extra-curricular activities. Participation in activities run by Cape Byron Rudolf Steiner School and/or outside organisations and any other outstanding individual accomplishments, including social service may be considered through this process.

Cape Byron Rudolf Steiner School (CBRSS) is an Independent School which is not fully funded by the Australian Government. The student completing the International Exchange from CBRSS will continue paying school fees throughout the duration of the Exchange to accommodate the exchange companion during his/her stay at CBRSS.

The Host Family will provide all meals (breakfast, lunch, snacks and dinner) and travel costs to and from school for the exchange student. They will not expect the student to work during his/her stay other than personal tidiness and general household chores, as being part of normal family life. Any special outings such as restaurants and holiday travels with the host family will be paid by the host family, unless the student has taken an independent outing or holiday.
