MARKET POLICY - Please read and sign above.

The school market is managed by the Cape Byron Steiner School Parents & Friends.

1. Food sold at the market must be homemade, of good, healthy, wholesome quality, minimal sugar, hygienically and lovingly prepared, containing no artificial colorings or flavourings, artificial sugars (such as aspartame), MSG (monosodium glutamate) and hydrogenated oils in any of the ingredients. No confectionery. Organic or biodynamic food is encouraged.
2. All stalls must display a clearly written ingredients list of all products sold.
3. Craft sold at the market must be homemade by the stall holder or a member of the stall holder's family. Craft must be free from any inherent danger to the end-user.
4. Other products may include organic fruit and vegetables and anthroposophically based goods.
5. Second hand goods - please specify above. Plastic toys will not be approved.
6. Busking - please specify above.
7. Stall holders are asked to bring their own change (float) and table - there are some card tables and trestles available.
8. Please keep packaging to a minimum avoiding the use of plastic and use the bin provided.
9. *Children operating a stall must have an adult to oversee the set-up, selling, pack-up and clean-up of the stall.
10. New products can only be sold if they or similar products are not already being sold.
11. Current stall holders who wish to sell a new product must put in a new application to the coordinator for approval before selling a new product.
12. 10% of takings is donated to the P&F and collected and recorded by the Market Coordinator at the close of each market.
